

CREATE YOUR OWN CONSTELLATION



MATERIALS

Black paper (construction paper or cardstock)

White acrylic paint

Small paintbrush or old toothbrush

Optional: metallic gel pens, white colored pencil, ruler

DIRECTIONS

1. Make the Star Field

Dip your brush lightly into white paint.

Hold it above the black paper.

Tap or flick the brush with your finger so tiny droplets scatter across the page.

Let the paint dry.

(This creates a natural, random starry background.)

2. Choose Your Constellation

Look at the star field and pick 5–10 dots that stand out to you.

Imagine a shape, creature, or symbol hidden among them.

Lightly connect those stars with a white pencil or gel pen.

3. Add Details

Draw the outline of your constellation's shape around the connected stars.

Give it a name.

Write a one-sentence story about what it represents.
